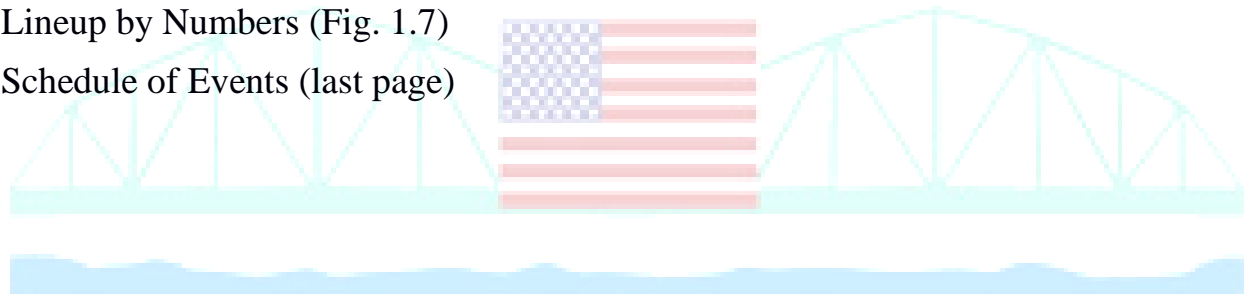

Figure 1.1 Parade Route

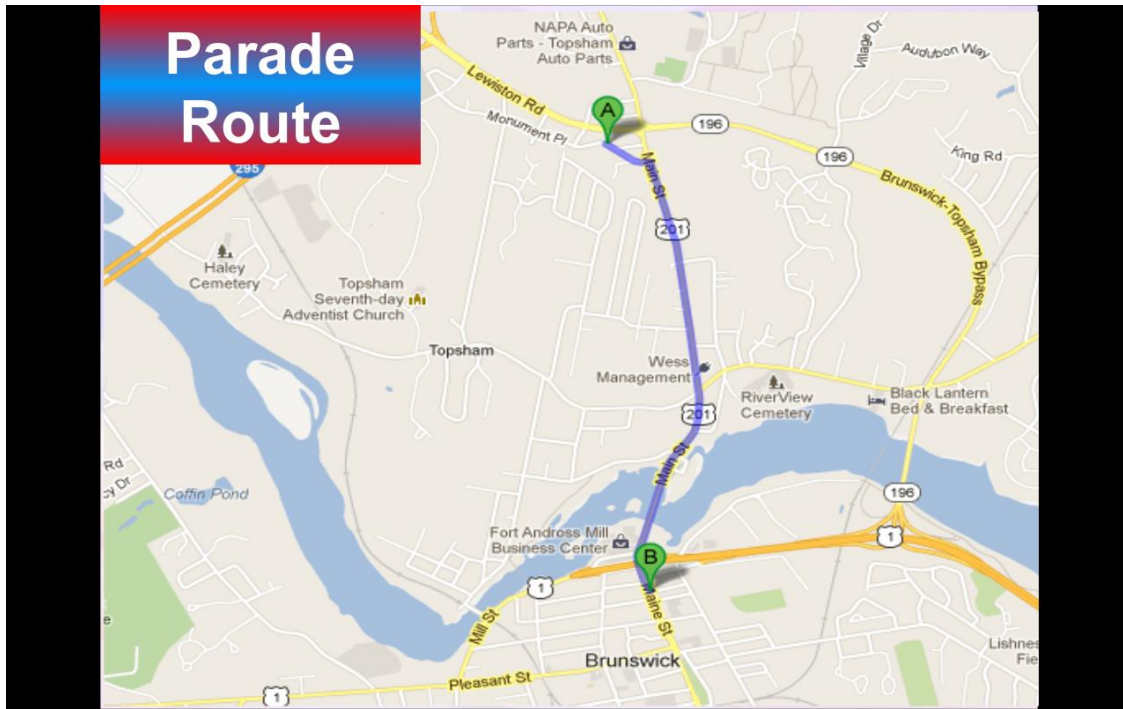



Figure 1.2 Staging Locations

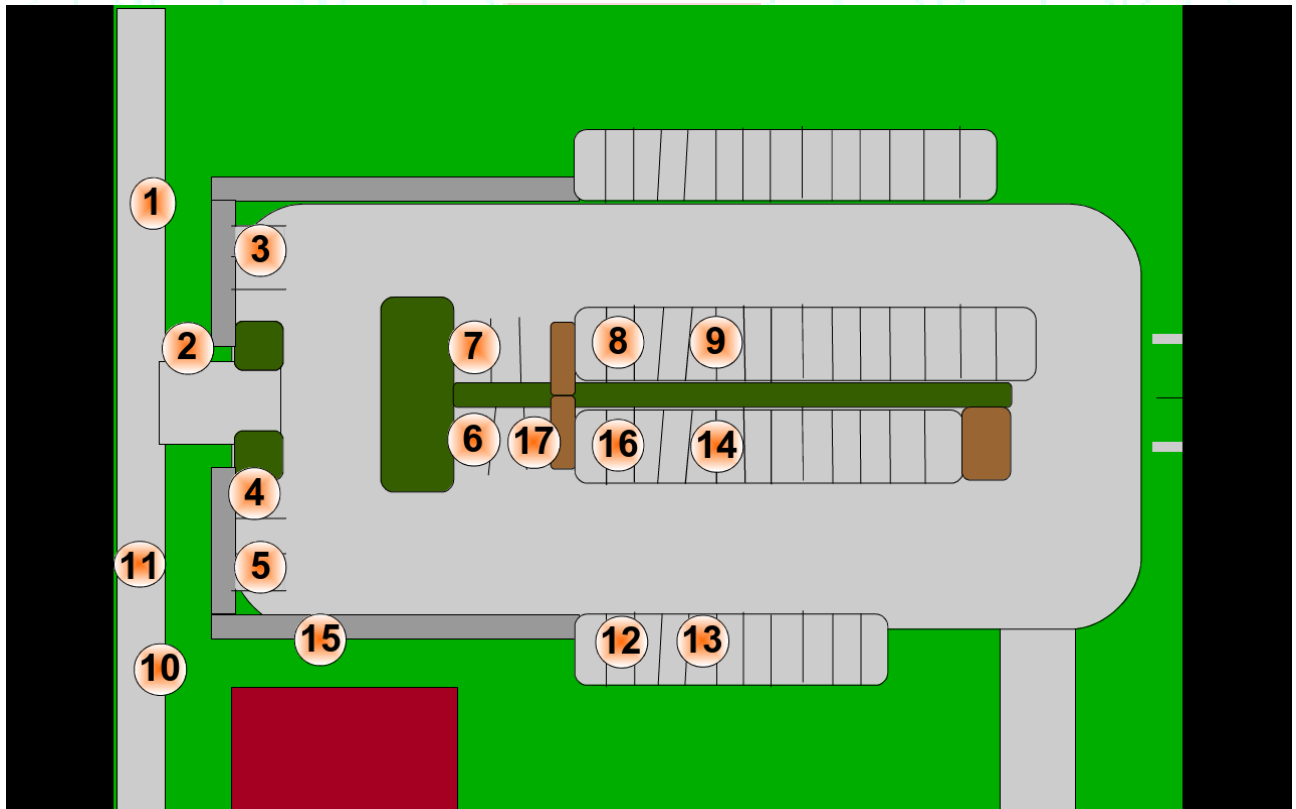
## Logistics

8:30 – Observance begins at Monument Place

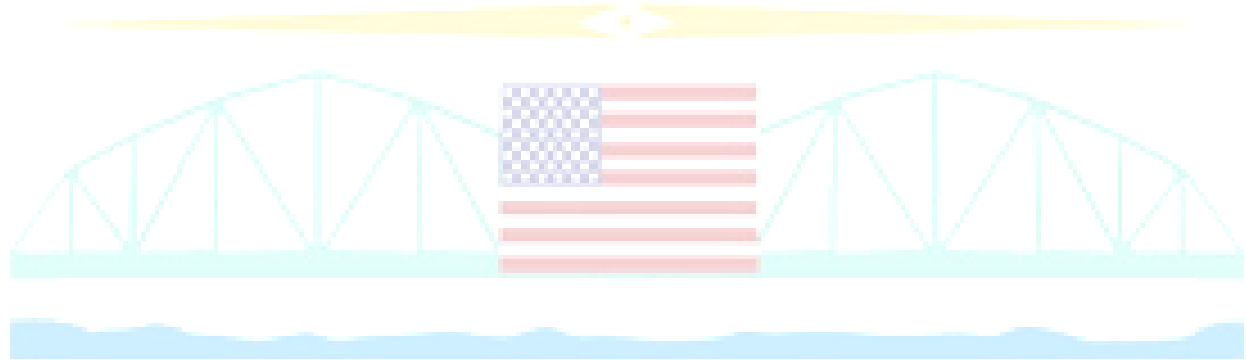
9:00 – Antique cars leave and Parade starts to Brunswick.
